

Shoot From The Hip

RULES: Other

START POSITION:

In the "Shooter's Box", with your firearm loaded with six rounds, from the "Low Ready" position or draw from the holster.

PROCEDURE:

At the start signal, engage each of the three targets with two rounds each, in any order.

All shots must be made with the hip shooting type of techniques, from the withdrawal position or as close as possible. Firearm may be extended, but not raised to eye level or even shoulder level. Not using the sights or dots. As if being surprised by opponents that are close enough to grab your firearm if you extended it. The off hand should be held to the chest, or out of the way (like in a pocket).

SCORING: Limited

ROUND COUNT: 6

TARGETS: 3

DISTANCE: One (1) to five (5) yards. The targets may move between stages.

SCORED HITS: Two per target - normal scoring (time plus penalties).
